


- Within the SystmOne **Home** screen.

All NWL ES Templates – Design Format

- **Enhanced Service Titles:** All templates have the headers on the first page/tab.
- **Tabs:** The majority of templates have several pages. These can be jumped to by using the tabs at the top of the template. If some tabs are hidden by the width of the page (i.e. mental health template) then click on the > or < on the right side of the tab line to see the other tabs.
- **Highlighted blue** areas mean they are Minimum Data Set (MDS) or KPI items which you need to complete for payment in most areas. We will comment on any blue areas that are slightly different.
- **MDS/KPI:** You will find the MDS (Minimum Data Set) (KPI's) for each Service either on the disclaimer page or a page near the end of the tabs.
- **Side Bar:** Handy links whilst in the template. Hover over the icon for information regarding the link. Click on the icon to take you to that link.
- **Information:** Click on the  in the template for more information.
- **Save:** Don't forget to save your patient after completing the template.
- **Patient Status Alerts:** Status Alerts are connected to the Data Quality Reports. If your templates are incomplete, then it will show on the patient Home Page. The status alert will tell you what is missing and if you click on action, this should take you straight to the appropriate template to complete the missing part of the MDS or KPI.
- **Contact the Team:** The disclaimer page also states how to contact the team if you have a query or feedback regarding the template.

If you are unable to get hold of the patient please see DNA policy and inform the DR who may need to contact the CMH team.
If patient reports any new side effects then please ask them to complete the GASS questionnaire. If you notice any severe side effects please inform the Dr PRIOR to giving the injection.

Lithium monitoring 3 monthly, 12 hours post-dose.

Please use the ICE profile 'antipsychotic and mood stabiliser monitoring' - this will offer the blood tests that are appropriate for the specific medication the patient is taking.

SMI and CCMI patients who are NOT taking antipsychotic medications only need these bloods taking every 3 years rather than annually.

- HbA1c affected by: Anaemia (Iron, B12), Chronic Renal Failure, Antiretrovirals, Dapsone, Haemoglobinopathies, Myelodysplastic disease, Rheumatoid Arthritis, Splenectomy, Splenomegaly.
- Antipsychotics can cause rapid glucose increase not detected by HbA1c.
- Prolactin mostly raised by: Risperidone, Amisulpride, Typical Antipsychotics.

Hyperprolactinaemia is usually not clinically significant with aripiprazole, clozapine, olanzapine, and quetiapine treatment at standard doses. See guidelines on link, in summary if:

- Prolactin concentration >118 ng/mL (>2500mIU/L) - refer to endocrinology to exclude prolactinoma
- Prolactin concentration 25-118ng/mL (530-2500mIU/L).
 - o Symptomatic - discuss with psychiatrist regarding switching medication
 - o Asymptomatic - monitor prolactin level and check for symptoms or consider switching meds

When switching from antipsychotics known to raise prolactin to one which reduces prolactin, a change in fertility can occur resulting in contraception being needed.

ECG should be performed annually for patients who are high risk: CVD and risk of long QTc. Offer ECG to all other patients on antipsychotics annually.

Launch Recovery and Stay Well plan

Currently SystemOne has a code for the longer Warwick-Edinburgh Mental Wellbeing Scale but not for the Short version and we await the implementation of this SNOMED code.

In order for GPs to be able to record the score on SystemOne with a corresponding SNOMED code, we have had to use the existing code. The template on SystemOne is pre-set with a scoring system for the long version of 14-70. Therefore, the work around has been to double the score for SWEMBS for the purposes of the Enhanced Service. When we compare national data we will halve the scores on SystemOne and implement the Rasch scoring recommended for SWEMWBS.

SWEMWBS is usually scored between 7 and 35, with each item scored between 1 and 5. The SWEMBS scoring for the template on SystemOne has been doubled for each item, where the WEMWBS code has been allocated. Therefore each item is scored from 2-10 rather than 1-5.

The SWEMWBS is a tool for assessing mental wellbeing at two points (or more) in time following an intervention. In this case, over a year of care in the Out of Hospital service.

Why is a well-being approach important? It enables us to do the following

- 1.Look at what makes people's lives go well.
- 2.Move beyond looking only at what people lack or need, and look at the positive things people bring to situations and communities. This in turn can help to think about the ways that people can be empowered to contribute to improvements in their own lives.
- 3.Move beyond a narrow focus on economic circumstances and towards the important areas of people's emotional and social needs.

The tool consists of 7 positively worded items with 5 response categories. It has been found to be quick and easy to use, has good face validity, is meaningful to people and designed to be used by people with all types of mental health problems.

It has been widely used nationally as a PROM 'patient reported outcome measure', to inform care and treatment, rather than evaluate a provider's performance.

It is not a diagnostic tool and there is no 'cut-off' score.

At present, it is impossible to be precise about how much change in scores is considered 'meaningful' and this may be different between individuals. Higher scores within an item reflect a greater overall mental wellbeing. For participants to recognise that their mental wellbeing is not good is not necessarily a bad thing. It can be the first step towards taking action to feel better. Overall scores may not change between the two points of measurement but there may be changes between items indicating different areas to focus on.
